

- 1. Bed and Breakfast accommodations on working farm; visitors have access to entire property; visitors have unsupervised farm work activities, hiking, hunting, fishing, and horseback riding available.
- 2. Bed and Breakfast accommodations on working farm; visitors have access to property, but not farm work hazards; visitors have hiking, hunting, fishing, and horseback riding available.
- 3. Bed and Breakfast accommodations on working farm; visitors can take walks on firm, even-surfaced pathways near guest facility and work areas; no additional activities.
- 4. Bed and Breakfast accommodations only; no farm business conducted; visitors can take walks on firm, even-surfaced pathways near guest facility; no additional activities.
- 5. Bed and Breakfast accommodations only; no farm business conducted; no additional activities.
