Least Protection

- Boarders/riders/visitors work with horses unsupervised; open flame at/near barn (barbecue grill, propane torch, etc.); smoking in stall area; absence of no trespassing signs; no EALA signs posted.
- Boarders/riders/visitors work with horses, no direct supervision by owner/employee; open flame within 30 ft. of facility, smoking in stall area; absence of no trespassing signs; no EALA signs posted.
- Boarders/riders/visitors work with horses, but with direct supervision of owner/employee; no source of open flame within/near facility; no smoking permitted but signs not posted; absence of no trespassing signs; EALA signs posted.
- Owner/employee only provides horse care; boarders/riders prepare horse to ride; no source of open flame within/near facility; no smoking and no trespassing signs posted/not enforced; EALA signs posted.
- Owner/employee only provides horse care and prepares horses for riding by boarders/visitors; no source of open flame within/near facility; no smoking and no trespassing signs posted/enforced; EALA signs
