- Riding on a non-defined trail; no liability waivers signed; horse supplied by ride operator; ASTM/SEI approved headgear not required; no lessons or supervision; no EALA signs.
- 2. Riding on a non-defined trail; no liability waivers signed; horse supplied by ride operator; ASTM/SEI approved headgear not required; minimal lessons and supervision; no EALA signs.
- Riding on a non-maintained, defined trail; no liability waivers signed and kept on file; horse owned by rider; ASTM/SEI approved headgear sometimes required; lessons with intermittent supervision by knowledgeable instructor or assistant; EALA signs.
- Riding on a somewhat maintained, defined trail; current liability waivers signed and kept on file; horse owned by rider; ASTM/SEI approved headgear required; lessons and/or some supervision by knowledgeable instructor or assistant; EALA signs.
- Riding on a well maintained, defined trail only; current liability waivers signed and kept on file; horse owned by rider; ASTM/SEI approved headgear required; lessons and/or constant supervision by knowledgeable instructor; EALA signs.
