- 1. Access to livestock buildings completely open; visitors and vendors report to anyone; no clothing and footwear disinfection or disposable boot requirements.
- 2. Unoccupied livestock areas not locked at night; visitors and vendors report to any farm personnel; no shower-in, shower-out disinfect facilities or clothing change required; no disposable boots or footbath required.
- 3. Unoccupied livestock areas locked at night; visitors and vendors report to any farm personnel; no shower-in, shower-out disinfect facilities or clothing change required; disposable boots provided, but not foot bath.
- 4. Unoccupied livestock areas locked at night; all visitors except vendors report to central office; no shower-in, shower-out disinfect facilities or clothing change required; footbath or disposable boots provided.
- 5. Unoccupied livestock areas locked; visitors and vendors report to central office; shower-in, shower-out disinfect facilities and clothing change required; foot bath or disposable boots provided.
